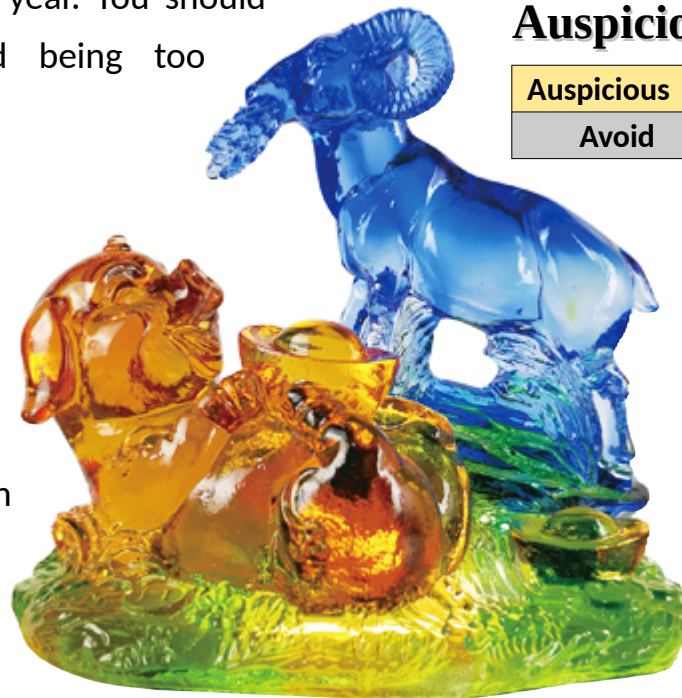
hazards when traveling in the autumn, especially when climbing a mountain or playing in the water. So remember to not take any risks and stay safe.
